



## PGS Income: 1st February 2020 -1st March 2020.

PGS giving across the diocese rose 1% from the month previous. This corresponds with an additional 39 donors donating through the PGS. 2 parishes registered a donor for the first time, bringing the total number of PGS parishes with donors to 124. Average giving per week per giver (excluding Gift Aid) via PGS is £16.32, compared to a national PGS average of £16.97.

## **PGS Coverage: Up to 12th March 2020**

Total parishes registered on the scheme has climbed to 159, up from 155 in the previous report. Sudbury remains the only deanery to surpass 50% coverage (58%). Loes/Waveney & Blyth have the highest number of parishes signed-up (14). PGS coverage across the diocese has risen to 36%.
