


Inspiring Ipswich Outcomes



This graph shows that the project:

- significantly exceeded the goal to make contact with 15,000 new people across the town.
- did not reach the target to help 7,500 people explore faith as per the project measurement definitions.
 - It was identified early in the project that an individual's exploration of faith is not linear and can occur over a variable period of time, which makes this much more difficult to track.
 - However, it was recognised that it was important to keep a focus on churches offering contextually appropriate ways to explore/engage with faith. This informed the topics of subsequent conferences (March 23 - Stepping Out in Faith and March 25 – Everyday Discipling).
- exceeded the goal to create new disciples by an additional 29.6%



This graph shows that the project:

- delivered 50% of its Church Plants goal.
 - There were multiple factors that contributed to this, and this learning is feeding into our forward planning.
- significantly exceeded the target to help start 26 new worshipping communities and new congregations.
 - Some new worshipping communities started and ended during the project, so the net figure represents the number of congregations/communities that were continuing at the last round of data collection in 2025.
