


Inspiring Ipswich Outcomes



This graph shows that the project:

- significantly exceeded the goal to make contact with 15,000 new people across the town by 242%.
- exceeded the goal to create new disciples by an additional 29.6%
- did not reach the target to help 7,500 people explore faith. It was identified early in the project that an individual's exploration of faith is not linear and can occur over a variable period of time, which makes this much more difficult to track. However, it was recognised that it was important to keep a focus on churches offering contextually appropriate ways to explore/engage with faith. This informed the topics of subsequent conferences (March 23 - Stepping Out in Faith and March 25 – Everyday Discipling).



This graph shows that the project:

- delivered 50% of its Church Plants goal. There were multiple factors that contributed to this, and this learning is feeding into our forward planning.
- significantly exceeded the target to help start 25 new worshipping communities and new congregations. Some new worshipping communities started and ended during the project reporting period, so the net figure represents the number of congregations/communities that were continuing at the end of the last data collection point.
