Leading a church school consists of 3 sessions over the school year. The sessions are cumulative and designed to build an understanding of what various aspects of Governance look like in the particular context of a church school, but could be used as standalones, depending on experience. The 3 sessions are:

1. Leading a church school – understanding the day by day
2. Strategy and Leadership – implementing change
3. Embedding the Christian Vision – living the vision

Each session is designed to encourage and support governors by giving them an opportunity to explore what governance looks like day to day, in a church school context.

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**Session 2: Strategy and Leadership – implementing change**

In this second session we will explore effective strategies to enable governors and Headteachers to work together to:

- ❖ Identify what needs to change
- ❖ Implement and sustain change
- ❖ Overcome possible barriers
