
ST AUGUSTINE'S IPSWICH

ST AUGUSTINE'S IS A CHARISMATIC EVANGELICAL ANGLICAN CHURCH, PART OF THE HTB NETWORK, BASED IN IPSWICH, THE COUNTY TOWN OF SUFFOLK.

We have a weekly worshipping community of around 100 adults every Sunday, rising to 140 thanks to a popular midweek communion service. Adding in regular children's, youth and community activities, the weekly reach of our gospel ministry is well over 300 people.



WE ARE AN INTENTIONALLY MISSIONAL CHURCH.

We believe God has called us to make disciples of Jesus as we gather in his name, grow deeper in his Word and give away what we've been given.

We are committed to doing whatever it takes to see God bring us growth in three key areas: children, young people and families, discipleship to the Lord Jesus through small groups and especially Alpha, and ministries of compassion to our community.

God is giving us unprecedented opportunities to reach out to children through our under-5s groups, a phenomenally popular Messy Church and more. A wellbeing café started shortly after lockdown has been a tremendous blessing to the isolated. We are seeing adults and children saved and added. In the last two years we have sent two church plants into our town: River Church, a new HTB church focussed on reaching young adults in the Waterfront area of the town; and Lindbergh Road Community Church, a small missional community focussed on a neighbourhood within our own parish. Both are seeing the fruit of new disciples of Jesus.

We are now in a new phase of rebuilding and growth, and though we have no immediate plans to plant again, we are eager to continue to play our part in growing the kingdom beyond our own parish.


We are seeking a full-time Associate Vicar for Mission and a part-time Youth Pastor.

WE ARE EXTREMELY WELL SITUATED AND EQUIPPED FOR MISSION.

Our location is excellent, positioned on the intersection of two busy roads and public transport routes. St Augustine's has a reputation as 'the church with the lighted cross' because of an illuminated cross on our tower, visible from distance at night.







As well as a medium-sized church, we have an airy and spacious meeting room (the Lantern Room), and a nearby hall complex (the Hub) where our office is based. We have plentiful parking on site.

St Augustine's is a single parish benefice serving a population of over 11,000 people in 4,500 households. It is the third largest benefice in Ipswich Deanery.

Housing in the parish is varied, ranging from local authority housing built in the 1920s to new executive style homes. There is a wide social mix and some cultural diversity. The employment is typical of the town, including insurance, IT, health, local authority, retail and service industries. Those who are retired often have long history in the area, and historic links to the church.

We're ten minutes from the centre of Ipswich, less than twenty to Felixstowe and the beautiful South Suffolk coast, and just over an hour by train from London.

Historically we have had missionally fruitful links with local schools, residential homes and nearby hospices and we are eager to renew them. Everyone is welcome, whoever they are and wherever they're from. We mean it.

We're a 'bring your Bible' kind of church.

We believe God speaks to us through the Bible, and that what he has to say to us is the most important thing we could hear. You don't need to know anything about the Bible before you come, but be prepared to be inspired and challenged by it when you do.

We're a 'come as you are' kind of church.

Everyone is welcome, whoever they are and wherever they're from. We mean it. We are a diverse bunch, from many parts of the world and with very different backgrounds brought together by the encounter we've all had with Jesus.

We're an 'it's all about Jesus' kind of church.

We're not very churchy in many ways – our music is informal, we don't dress up for Sundays and we try not to use too many confusing words. But we love to talk about Jesus who has changed our lives and who changes them a little more every day as we follow him and share life together.
