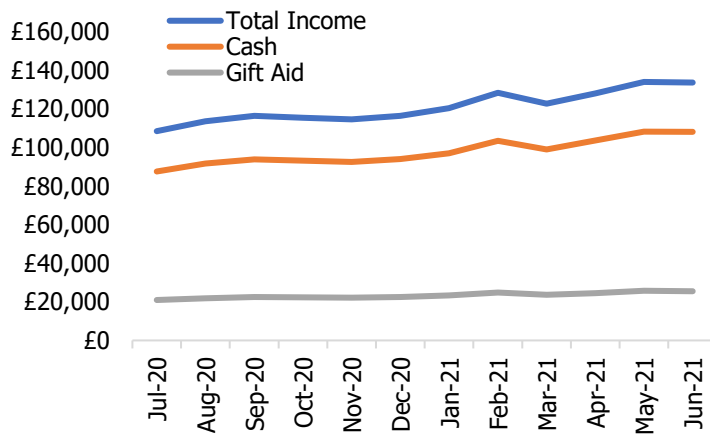


PGS Income: 1st May 2021 - 1st June 2021. 2021 Targets: 280 Parishes. Donors: 1,800

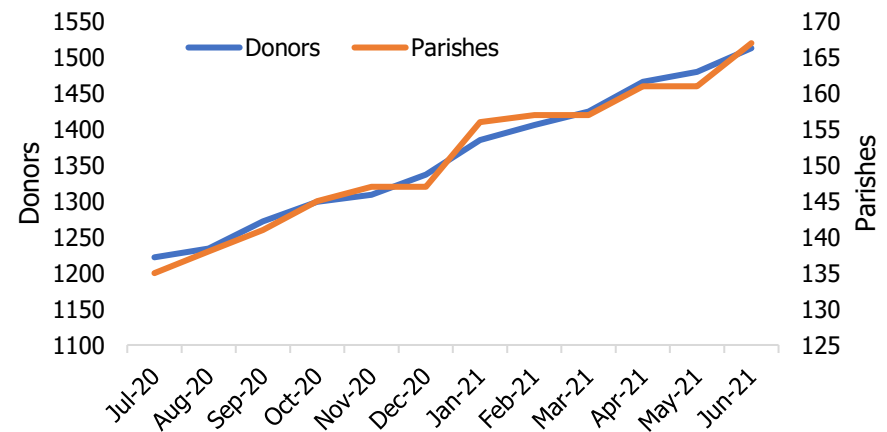
PGS income remained stable from the year previous despite 33 additional donors giving through the scheme. This is because the quarterly and annual givers in the previous month contributed more than in this reporting period. Average giving per week per giver (excluding Gift Aid) via PGS is £15.45, compared to the national PGS average of £16.73.

PGS Coverage: Up to 10 June 2021

Total parishes registered on the scheme has grown to 202. Sudbury deanery has the highest sign-up rate (68%), with Clare close behind (64%). Clare features the highest number of parishes signed-up (18). PGS coverage across the diocese rose to 45%.
