- Check your RE Long-term plan for the upcoming academic year. For CHURCH schools: The guidance from the Diocesan Board of Education for this academic year advises that all church schools teach 50% Christianity in KS1 and KS2. This works out as three Christian enquiries/units out of the six across every year group.
- Check the RE pages of your website: it should include your policy and long-term plan. It is also best practice to include details on the right to withdraw from RE.


