A Rocha UK is a Christian charity working for the protection and restoration of the natural world and committed to equipping Christians and churches in the UK to care for the environment. It launched the Eco Church scheme to respond to the biblical mandate to care for the earth, and

demonstrate the Christian hope for God's world.

Over 148 parishes have already signed up for the A Rocha Eco Church scheme and we think it could be more! Has your church signed up?

Getting your church involved in eco projects can be a great way to invite new people into your church community and this could be a great focus for your church's Growing in Number strategy. Ideas such as setting up a wildlife area in your churchyard and asking a local school to help plant it, having a youth eco group, or organising a village litter pick could enable you to build relationships with different groups of people in your

communities.

The Eco Church schemes allows your church to work towards awards Bronze, Silver and Gold to show your committ to the environment. To start your journey to winning the prestigious awards, complete their Eco Survey to gauge where your church currently is in relation to the three different levels; you may find you already qualify for an Eco Church Award! You can register here.

A Rocha also has two nature reserves, Foxearth Meadows and Wolf Fields, which are also demonstration sites to inspire and enable others to manage land for the benefit of people and nature. Foxearth Meadows is near Sudbury, just over the border in North Essex and supports events and activities such as the **Connecting climate and nature webinar on Thursday 22 July, 11.30am - 1.00pm** You can sign up here.
