Contactless Donations Pilot Scheme



We are excited to announce that we are partnering with the National Giving Team's contactless donation pilot. This is part of the Church of England's broader National strategy, which has committed £1.25m to equip thousands more churches to accept contactless

and digital payments over the next two years. The pilot will have a focus on facilitating internet connectivity alongside contactless giving. Successful applicants will receive a free contactless donation unit (chosen by The National Giving team), support for mobile broadband (if you opt for mobile data contract), training and ongoing support for a year from both the National and Diocesan Giving teams. Please note, to take part in the pilot, your church will need to have wifi installed, being installed soon, or a mobile phone signal in their building.


