## War heroes who lost their lives in Suffolk remembered in a moving ceremony



The 80th anniversary of an American bomber crash in Suffolk has been marked with new evidence about the death of the crew.

The American WWII B-17 bomber named Little Boy Blue crashed just outside Thurston after a midair collision, leaving eight dead with two survivors.

The tragedy occurred on 19 July 1944

and now a poignant memorial service has been held to commemorate the crash on land owned by Steve Honeywood. Guests were told that a painstaking search undertaken by volunteers led by Cotswold Archaeology had uncovered new evidence about the remains of three young airmen who were still aboard the bomber when it crashed. The young Americans were unaccounted for, denying their families closure and the opportunity for formal funerals.

# Suffolk comes top at Ride and Stride's annual fundraising event

A Ride and Stride church fundraising day was held in 22 counties in England in September 2023, and we are delighted to announce that Suffolk raised the most money with a total of £200,312.70. The total raised nationally to help preserve and repair churches buildings was £1,208,115 with Suffolk contributing 16.5%. The national Ride and Stride event started in Suffolk as a sponsored bike ride and then spread across the country. Thank you to all our volunteers, riders, strider, drivers and supporters... every pound raised helps to keep our wonderful church buildings going.

Suffolk Historic Churches Trust (SHCT) Ride and Stride and Pedal & Drive car rally takes place each year and sees several thousand cyclists and walkers of all ages (and drivers of vintage and classic cars) taking part in the fundraising event. The next one will take place on Saturday 14 September 2024.

**SHCT grant awards:** The money awarded in grants to churches in June was £43,000 to be shared between eight churches: Alderton, Bradfield St George, Framlingham, Freston, Horham, Ketteburgh, Sylham and Cowlinge. The work for which the grants were awarded included masonry repairs to an unstable buttress, buttress and porch repairs, replacing of a vestry floor, plasterwork repairs to chancel, nave and porch ceilings and walls, repairs to roof tiles, eaves, gutters and gables.
